FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PASTORAL SOLAR ENERGY BOREHOLE (LOT 1) IN THE LOCALITY OF KAHEO, COMMUNE OF DARGALA, DEPARTMENT OF DIAMARE AND TWO (02) PRODUCTIVE BOREHOLES EQUIPPED WITH HUMAN POWER PUMPS (LOT 2) RESPECTIVELY IN THE LOCALITIES OF TCHABAHOL-GUIZIGA, COMMUNE OF MERI, DEPARTMENT OF DIAMARE AND MEME, COMMUNE OF MORA, DEPARTMENT OF MAYO SAVA, EXTREME NORTH REGION.

FINANCING: MIDIMA OPERATIONAL BUDGET, Fiscal Year 2023

1. Purpose of the Call for Tenders.

Within the framework of the implementation of the performance plan of the Integrated Development Mission of the Mandara Mountains (MIDIMA) for the financial year 2023, the Director General of MIDIMA (Contracting Authority), is launching a National Open Tender for the construction works of a solar powered pastoral borehole (lot 1) in the locality of KAHEO, Dargala Commune, Diamaré Department and two (02) productive boreholes equipped with human power pumps (lot 2) respectively in the localities of TCHABAHOL-GUIZIGA, Méri Commune, Diamaré Department and MEME, Mora Commune, Mayo Sava Department, Far North Region, according to the distribution in the table below:

2. Consistency of the works

The works comprise:

Lot 1: Solar powered pastoral drilling

- Hydro-geophysical studies and site installation;
- Drilling and equipment of the borehole;
- Drilling and equipping of the borehole; Drilling and equipping of the borehole;
- Development and flow testing of the borehole;

- Water analysis and treatment;
- Drilling and equipping the borehole; Drilling and equipping the borehole
- Construction of the water storage tank/castle;
- Construction of a two-tap standpipe;
- Supply and installation of solar panels;
- Supply of a maintenance kit to the management committee
- Supply and installation of pipes;
- Construction of water troughs;
- Installation of a photovoltaic field;
- Securing the site with a wire fence;
- Supply and installation of a solar energy pump;
- Taking into account socio-environmental aspects;
- Setting up and training management committees.

The solar pumping system includes:

- A drilled and equipped hole
- A standpipe;
- A storage tank/castle;
- Solar panels mounted on supports;
- A wire mesh fence to protect the panels with a concrete post support and a chain link fence along the fence;
- The submerged pump and its accessories;
- The supply pipes for the troughs and the hydrant.

Batch 2: boreholes equipped with human powered pumps

- Geophysical and hydrogeological studies
- Installation of the site;
- Construction of the borehole;
- Development and pumping test;
- Surface development;
- Supply and installation of pumps;
- Construction of boreholes;
- The construction of the wastewater drainage channels;
- The construction of curbstones with anti-sludge, drawing area and portion;
- Disinfection of boreholes;
- Physicochemical and bacteriological analysis of the water;
- The lining of the constructed works;
- The commissioning of the works;
- The setting up of management committees and their training.

3. Participation and origin

Participation in this invitation to tender is open on equal terms to companies and firms or groups of companies under Cameroonian law, with proven experience in the field of hydraulics.

By this invitation to tender, interested companies are invited to provide in their bids, the authentic information that will allow the selection of the company that can provide the services after a thorough and objective evaluation of its file.

4. Time limits for execution

The maximum period foreseen by the project owner for the execution of the works, subject of this invitation to tender, is:

That is to say an overall period of four (04) months or 120 calendar days. This period runs from the date of notification and the service order to start the works.

10. Acquisition of Tender Documents

The tender documents may be obtained from the Secretariat of the MIDIMA General Management, as soon as this notice is published, on presentation of a receipt for payment of a non-refundable sum of fifty thousand (50,000) CFA francs as the cost of purchasing the tender documents (DAO), payable to the CAS-ARMP Account No. **97568660005-16** at one of the twelve (12) approved BICEC branches throughout the national territory, the list of which is attached.

11. Submission of the offers

Each tender, written in French or English, in seven (07) copies of which one (01) original and six (06) legible copies marked as such, in conformity with the requirements of the Tender Documents, must be deposited in a sealed envelope against a receipt, at the Secretariat of MIDIMA's General Management, no later than 01 MAI 2023 at 10.00 a.m., local time, and must be marked:

N.B.: Tenders received after the closing date and time for submission of tenders will not be received.

12. Admissibility of tenders

The required documents in the administrative file must be submitted in originals or in copies certified by the competent issuing department or an administrative authority, in accordance with the provisions of the Special Rules for Invitations to Tender.

They must be dated within three (3) months prior to the date of submission of bids or have been prepared after the date of signing the tender notice.

Any bid that is incomplete in accordance with the requirements of the bidding documents will be declared inadmissible. In particular, the absence of a bid bond issued by a first class bank approved by the Ministry of Finance.

13-Opening of bids

The opening of the bids shall take place in one (01) session on 01 MAI 2023, at 11:00 a.m. sharp in the MIDIMA meeting room in Maroua, in the presence of the bidders. Only the bidders may attend this opening session or be represented by one person (even in the case of a group) of their choice who has a perfect knowledge of the file.

14- Evaluation criteria

The evaluation of the tenders will take place in three (03) stages:

- 1st stage: Verification of the conformity of the administrative file of each tenderer.
- Stage 2: Technical evaluation of administratively compliant bids.
- Stage 3: Verification of the financial offers of the companies whose technical and administrative offers have obtained the minimum marks required.

The criteria for evaluating the offers are as follows:

14-1 -Eliminatory criteria

14-1-1- Administrative documents

- a) Incomplete file or documents not in conformity after 48 hours;
- b) Falsified or unauthenticated documents;
- c) Absence of a bid bond.

14-1-2- Technical offer

- a) False declaration, falsified or scanned documents;
- b) Turnover in the field of hydraulics over the last three (03) years of at least or equal to ten million (10,000,000) CFA francs;
- c) Not having justified the realization during the last three years, as main contractor, of a hydraulic works construction site;
- d) Failure to include in the technical bid the section "organization, methodology and planning";
- e) Failure to satisfy at least 70% of the essential criteria.

14-1-3: Financial offer

- a) Incomplete financial offer;
- b) Omission of a quantified unit price in the financial offer;
- c) Absence of a price sub-detail.

14-2: Essential criteria

The evaluation of the technical offers will be made on the basis of the 52 essential criteria below:

- a) Presentation on 3 criteria;
- b) The company's management staff on 12 criteria;
- c) The site equipment to be used on 12 criteria;
- d) The execution methodology on 13 criteria;
- e) References and pre-financing capacity of the company out of 12 criteria.

16-Award of the Contract

The General Manager of MIDIMA, the Contracting Authority, shall award the contract to the tenderer whose technically qualified tender is assessed as the lowest after checking its prices and judged to be substantially in conformity with the Tender Documents.

17. Period of Validity of Tenders

Tenderers shall remain bound by their tenders for a period of ninety (90) days from the deadline for submission of tenders.
